

## TOWN OF BATH

### TOWN MEETING WARRANT

To the Inhabitants of the Town of Bath qualified to vote in Town Affairs. You are hereby notified to meet at the Bath Village School cafetorium on Tuesday, March 11, 2054 at seven o'clock in the evening to act upon the following subjects:

- Article 1** To choose one Selectmen for three years, a Treasurer for one year, one Trustee of the Trust Funds for three years, one Library Trustee for three years, one Cemetery Trustee for three years, one Cemetery Trustee for two years, one Auditor for one year and other necessary officers for the ensuing year.
- Article 2** To hear reports of officers and agents heretofore chosen and to pass any vote relating thereto.
- Article 3** To see if the town will vote to raise and appropriate the sum of \$1,000,000 for the construction of a new Highway Department Garage, \$150,000 will come from the Capital Reserve for this purpose, further to authorize the issuance of not more than \$850,000 of bonds or notes in accordance with the provisions of the Municipal Finance Act (RSA 33) and to authorize the Board of Selectmen to issue and negotiate such bonds or notes and to determine the rate of interest thereon. This special warrant article will be a non-lapsing appropriation per RSA 32:7, VI and will not lapse until the building is complete or by December 31, 2030, whichever is sooner. The Selectmen recommend this appropriation. (3/5 ballot vote required).
- Article 4** To see if the town will vote to raise and appropriate the sum of \$1,586,181 for general municipal operations. This article does not include appropriations contained in special or individual articles addressed separately. The Selectmen recommend this appropriation.
- Article 5** To see if the town will vote to raise and appropriate the sum of \$139,750 for the purchase of a new Highway Department 1 Ton Truck, \$40,000 will come from the Capital Reserve Fund for this purpose and \$19,046 will come from grant money from Grafton County, further to authorize the issuance of not more than \$80,704 of bonds or notes in accordance with the provisions of the Municipal Finance Act (RSA 33) and to authorize the Board of Selectmen to issue and negotiate such bonds or notes and to determine the rate of interest thereon. This special warrant article will be a non-lapsing appropriation per RSA 32:7 VI and will not lapse until the delivery of the truck is complete or December 31, 2030. The Selectmen recommend this appropriation. (3/5 ballot vote required).
- Article 6** To see if the town will vote to raise and appropriate the sum of \$50,000 for renovations to the basement of the Bath Town Hall for the Police Department. \$20,000 of this amount to come from the Capital Reserve for the Land/Building Highway, Police, Town Offices, \$20,000 to come from the fund balance and the remainder to be raised by taxes. The Selectmen recommend this appropriation
- Article 7** To see if the Town will vote to raise and appropriate the sum of \$20,000 to be placed in the Road Maintenance Equipment Capital Reserve Fund. The Selectmen recommend this appropriation.
- Article 8** To see if the Town will vote to raise and appropriate the sum of \$10,000 to be added to the Road Repairs Capital Reserve Fund. The Selectmen recommend this appropriation.
- Article 9** To see if the Town will vote to raise and appropriate the sum of \$10,000 to be added to the Fire Department Vehicles Capital Reserve Fund. The Selectmen recommend this appropriation.
- Article 10** To see if the Town will vote to raise and appropriate the sum of \$15,000 to be added to the Police Vehicles Capital Reserve Fund previously established. The Selectmen recommend this appropriation.
- Article 11** To see if the Town will vote to raise and appropriate the sum of \$5,000 to be added to the Generator Capital Reserve Fund previously established. The Selectmen recommend this appropriation.

- Article 12** To see if the Town will vote to raise and appropriate the sum of \$20,000 to be added to the Capital Reserve Fund for Land/Buildings for the Highway, Police and Town Offices. The Selectmen recommend this appropriation.
- Article 13** To see if the town will vote to change the purpose of the existing future purchase of Fire Department Vehicles Capital Reserve Fund to the Fire Department vehicles or vehicle repairs Capital Reserve Fund; further to name the Board of Selectmen as agents to expend from said fund. (2/3 vote required).
- Article 14** To transact any other business that may legally come before this meeting.
